

## **Borger ISD is offering ticket sales online for Volleyball Games**

**Borger ISD plans to allow fans to purchase high school volleyball tickets remotely on the website <http://www.ticketspicket.com/>.** You will have to create an account then search for Borger events. Online ticket sales will be available for BHS and BMS volleyball games.

We will stop selling tickets when we reach the 50% capacity threshold which is set by the UIL.

At any time, the percentage of fans allowed by the UIL could change which would result in us either decreasing or increasing the number of tickets sold on a weekly basis.

There will be 494 tickets sold if we play in one gym and 619 tickets sold for volleyball games if both gyms are used. This number is what will be allowed in the stands in both gyms.

Ticket sales for home games will take place according to this plan and effects home games only. We are working with our opponents as far as purchasing tickets when we travel out of town.

On Monday, a code will be sent to all participants' parents via email for Tuesday's home game. Participants include players, cheer, and trainers. Parents will be able to purchase up to four tickets. You will also be able to pick adult or student tickets. At noon we will open it up to the rest of the public. Ticket sales will be cut off at midnight Monday night. The remaining number of tickets will be sold on Tuesday at the ticket window.

On Wednesday we will send a code to all participants' parents via email for Saturday's home game. Participants include players, cheer, and trainers. Parents will be able to purchase up to four tickets. You will also be able to pick adult or student tickets. At noon we will open it up to the rest of the public. Ticket sales will be cut off at midnight Thursday night. The remaining number of tickets will be sold on Saturday at the ticket window.

All persons entering the gym will undergo COVID-19 screening.

All gym visitors ages 10 and older must always wear masks within the gym unless they have medical documentation stating they are exempt.

Exceptions include:

- A medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a mask covering.
- While consuming food or drink.
- Any reason or circumstance indicated under Executive Order GA-29
