The purpose for College Board Advanced Placement courses is to prepare students for college work and/or AP exams that give students the opportunity to receive college credit. Typically, successful AP students are task-oriented, proficient in reading, able to prioritize their time, and encouraged by parents/guardians to do well academically. Honors courses are designed to prepare ninth, tenth, and eleventh-grade students for AP courses and the AP exam. AP courses are different from the regular curriculum in that they are taught with college curricula and college level materials. **The cost of the AP exam is \$91.00 per test due by _____; the reduced fee is \$55 per test. Payments must be made with a cashier's check or money order, no personal checks or cash will be accepted.**

Policies:

- No late work is accepted from Honors /AP students.
- Make-up work from absences is one day for each day not in class
- Students in these courses will not be allowed to retest.
- Students in Honors /AP courses do NOT receive 10 points added to their **AVERAGES** as some may believe. The addition of ten points for AP/ Honors /Concurrent courses is done for **RANKING** purposes only and will not change your student's grade at any time.
- Students may withdraw from a Honors /AP course at anytime based on the results of a conference to determine the correct placement of the student in the regular classroom. Special circumstances may apply; however, most schedule changes will be based on students that are at-risk of failure in the Honors /AP course.

The student should understand that the work load for any Honors /AP course is more extensive than that of a regular course. In addition, the student should be able to organize his/her time well in order to maintain a passing average throughout the course. If the student needs extra help, teachers are available for tutorials before and/or after school. Parents should help in the organization of study time for assignment completion and should encourage the student to do well. Parents are welcome to contact the teacher if there is a concern.
